Dear Laboratory Colleague,

I am writing to inform you that the Chromogranin A service provided by the Reference Biochemistry laboratory at King's College Hospital (part of Viapath Analytics LLP) will now be referred to Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust.

Our chosen referral lab is fully UKAS accredited (UKAS 8673) for the assay. The reporting unit for Chromogranin A will change from nmol/L to pmol/L and reference range will be 0 – 60 pmol/L.

Please note that Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust referral laboratory requires an EDTA sample, with a minimum volume requirement of 6mL of blood for the full gut hormone profile, and 2mL of blood for individual Chromogranin A requests.
