- Patient's full name (first name & surname)
- Date of Birth (DOB)
- NHS/hospital number
- Date sample was taken
- The requestor's name or location
- Specimen bottles are tightly sealed to avoid leakage in transit
- Additional tests can often be performed with only a small increase in sample volume the volumes shown on EPR or t-Quest need not be accumulated.

Tests available on emergency basis

The following tests are available on an emergency basis for the immediate diagnosis and management of a patient after normal working hours, Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays:

- **Serum** Renal, bone, liver profiles, amylase, paracetamol, salicylate, iron (overdoses only), Troponin T
- **Plasma** Glucose (fluoride/oxalate tube)
- **Blood** Whole blood appropriately heparinised for blood gases. Remove needle before transporting to laboratory or sample will be discarded.
- **CSF** protein (plain bottle) and glucose (fluoride/oxalate tube)
- Urine sodium, osmolality

The specific tests required must be indicated on the request form/ EPR request. Any additional tests not on the list that are required must be discussed with the Duty Biochemist who is available on-call at all times, switchboard will contact via mobile phone.
